
### **CALL FOR PROPOSALS**

# University Wide Teaching Conference Getting to Know You: The Faculty/Student Connection

May 22, 2019 - Grafton Campus

Sharing experiences and interacting with peers can have far-reaching impacts on student learning. As environments and techniques for teaching evolve more rapidly, faculty are challenged to think deeply about connecting with a new generation of students. Many Tufts faculty have engaged in new scholarly practices and discovered and researched new ways of looking at how they connect with students in and outside the classroom.

The committee is soliciting proposals with (a) an innovative idea for in the classroom/lab/clinical setting (b) teaching challenges that they have solved, or (c) new ideas that create connections with a new generation of students. We welcome proposals that highlight collaboration between faculty and students.



Program Topics: Sessions are invited that relate to:

- Connecting with Students inside the Classroom, clinic, or lab
- Mentoring and Advising Students
- Connecting with Students outside the classroom
- Connecting with Students in innovative ways through technology
- Fostering community in and outside the classroom
- Creating faculty, student partnerships for growing and learning

Workshops are 45 or 90 minutes in length and should provide the opportunity for participants to actively engage in the material. Typically, this means a short presentation of the topic (10-15 minutes) light on slides. Followed by an activity, sharing of ideas and materials and/or small or large groups discussions.
