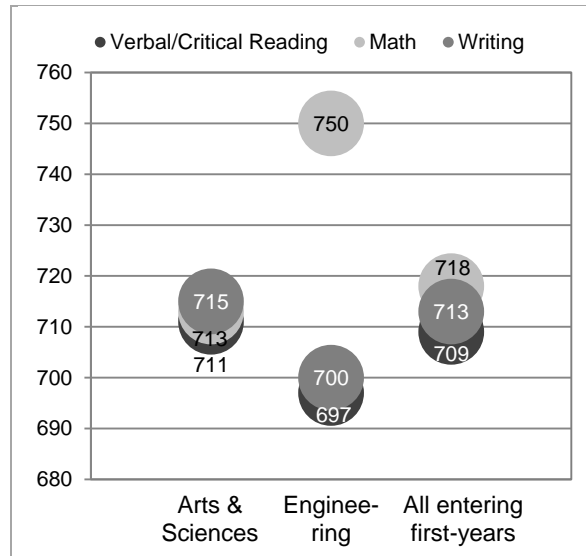

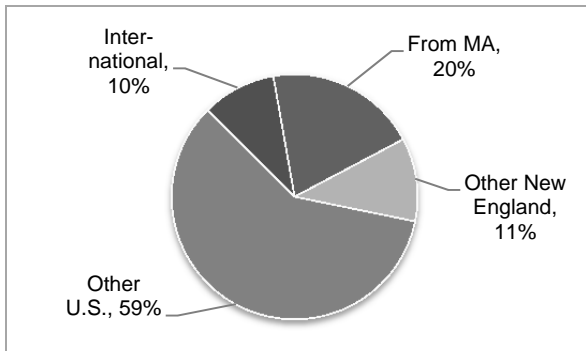

## Undergraduate Entering Class

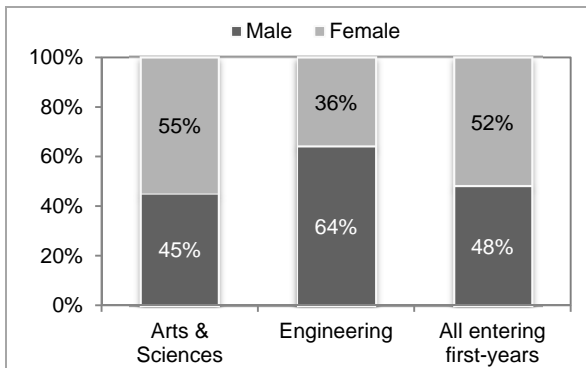
### Class of 2016: Average SAT scores

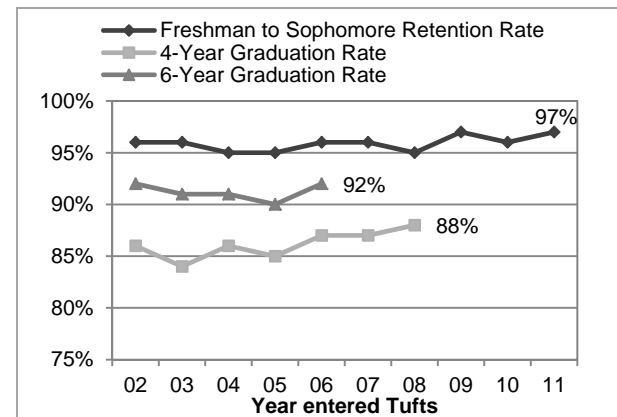
