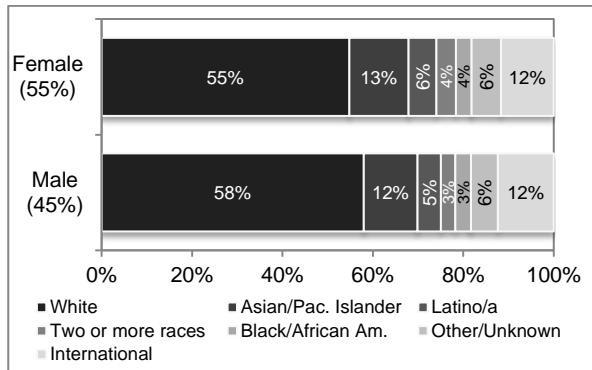

## Degree-Seeking Students by Race/Gender<sup>2</sup>

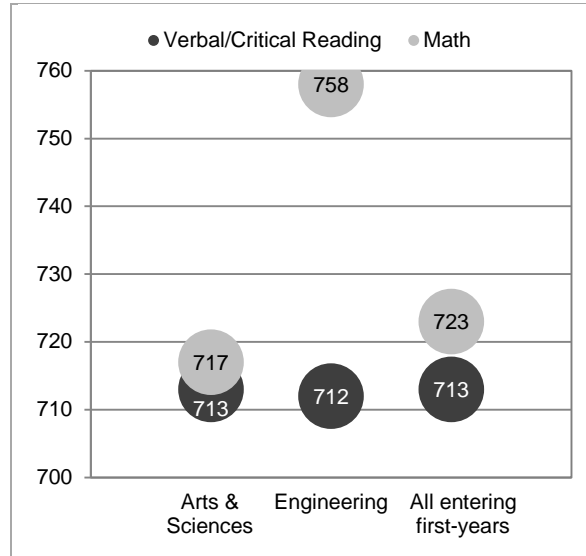

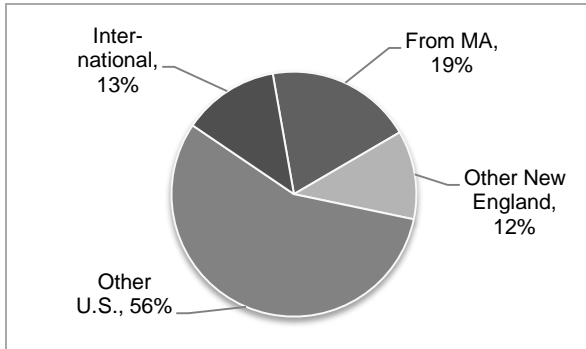

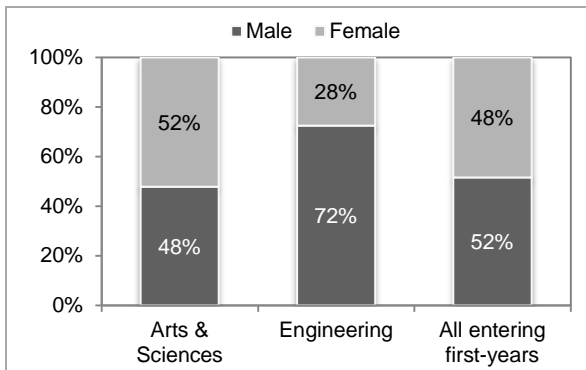
### Class of 2019: Average SAT scores

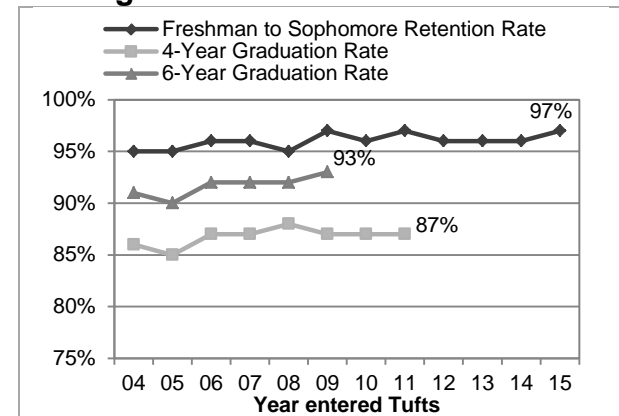
